Vendor House Rules .2009

Host to the ARRL Maryland State Convention

March 28 and 29, 2009

1. No vendor shall be allowed entrance to the fairgrounds prior to 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 27, 2009 without PRIOR written authorization by the GBH&C.
2. Neither the GBH&C, BARC Inc., nor any person acting as agent for the aforementioned groups shall be held liable for any lost or stolen property.
3. Persons without building passes will not be allowed to enter the buildings prior to 8:00 a.m. or after 5:00 p.m. on the days of the show.
4. Sales of food and/or drink are PROHIBITED.
5. Sales of firearms, stun guns, blow guns, rifles, swords, knives with blades over 4 inches long, cross bows, mace, pepper spray, and/or any other type of offensive or defensive weapon are strictly prohibited.
6. Adult related materials may NOT be displayed if they are deemed inappropriate for general attendees (both adult and minor) by agents of the GBH&C or BARC Inc. These materials include (but are NOT limited to) video and data CDs, software, floppy disks, mechanical or electronic items, magazines, posters, or other printed matter. Items of an Adult nature, such as software, CDs, printed matter, etc. MAY be sold at the show, provided:
(a) Such sales are only made to persons older than 18 years of age, as verified by the vendor making such sales; and (b) The only display advertising shall be a single sign that reads "ADULT MATERIAL AVAILABLE. PLEASE INQUIRE FOR MORE INFORMATION." No other advertising, samples, disk jackets, CD covers, video monitors, or electronic displays will be permitted. It is the sole responsibility of the vendor to verify the age of the potential purchaser. Sales and display of "Adult" material may also be subject to government laws or regulations.
7. **No vehicles will be allowed in any building's sales area during show hours.**
8. Open flames are prohibited on the fairground property except in designated areas.
9. No stakes or poles may be driven into any paved area.
10. All advertising emitting sound must be kept at a minimum so as not to disturb surrounding vendors.
11. Vendors are expected to leave their sales space clean. Take your trash with you or place it in the proper container.
12. No animals except Guide Animals will be allowed in any fairgrounds building.
13. Sales of Hazardous Materials is prohibited
14. Any violation of the above rules may, at the sole discretion of the agents of the GBH&C or BARC Inc., result in the removal of the vendor from the show. Show fees, charges, or costs will NOT be refunded. Any vendor so removed may not be invited back to any future shows.

Any and all decisions or judgments made by an agent of the GBH&C or BARC Inc. shall be final.

I have read the Rules of the Greater Baltimore Hamboree and Computerfest and agree to be bound by them. I understand that the State of Maryland may require the collection and remittance of Sales Tax. I agree to report my Sales Tax information to the State of Maryland Comptroller's Office.
